- ※ 1<sup>st</sup> round is for 2nd Violin Assistant Principal, Tutti and Clarinet Tutti candidates Trumpet is single round during the 2<sup>nd</sup> Round Audition period
- \* KBSSO does not reimburse travel and accommodation expenses
- \* No piano accompanist is necessary for the live audition
